# Directions to the University of San Diego

## From the NORTH

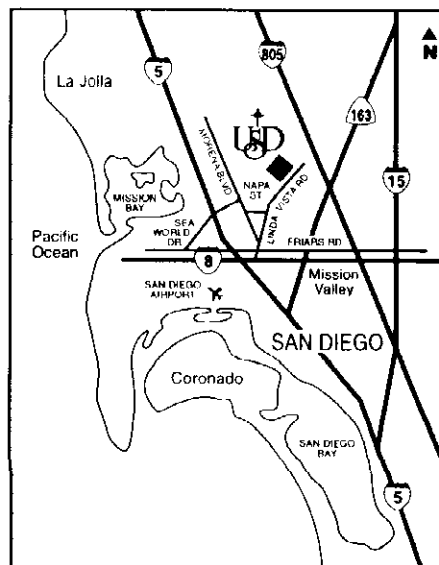
On Interstate 5 (South), exit at Sea World Drive / Tecolote Road (just past the Hilton Hotel on Mission Bay). Turn left on Tecolote Road, right on Morena Blvd., and left on Napa Street to Linda Vista Road. Make a left onto Linda Vista Road and go up the hill (pass Marian Way). Make a left at USD's Main Driveway. Ask for directions from the Kiosk Officer or at the Parking Services / Visitor Information Office.

## From the SOUTH (including San Diego's International Airport)

From Interstate 5 (North) exit onto Interstate 8 (East). Exit at Morena Blvd. (first off-ramp), veer right onto Linda Vista Road and go up the hill (pass Marian Way). Make a left at USD's Main Driveway. Ask for directions from the Kiosk Officer or at the Parking Services / Visitor Information Office.

## From the EAST

On Interstate 8 (West), exit at Morena Blvd. Veer right onto Linda Vista Road and go up the hill (pass Marian Way). Make a left at USD's Main Driveway. Ask for directions from the Kiosk Officer or at the Parking Services / Visitor Information Office.

## Policy

The University of San Diego Parking Policy requires that all vehicles operated on U.S.D. property observe ALL THE LAWS of the California Vehicle Code, San Diego Municipal Code and University Regulations. The speed limit on campus is 15 m.p.h. and 10 m.p.h. in the parking garages.

Cars operated on campus must have valid license plates and current registration stickers. Any person driving on campus must have a valid driver's license in their possession.

## Parking Permits

Parking permits are required, for all guests and visitors 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. All vehicles including motorcycles, mopeds, and motor scooters require permits.

Permits are issued by the Department of Public Safety Parking Services Office.

Parking permits **MUST** be displayed according to instructions given when the permit is issued.

Parking permits are **NOT TRANSFERABLE** to another person or vehicle.

Parking permits are the property of the University of San Diego, and may be recalled at any time.

The purchase of a parking permit does not guarantee parking space availability.

## Responsibility

The responsibility for finding legal parking spaces rest with the motor vehicle operator. Lack of space is not a valid reason for violating these regulations. A traffic citation and/or towing (at the owner's expense) is one of the enforcement mechanisms against illegally parked vehicles. **NO LIABILITY** for loss or damage to any vehicle or its contents, nor liability for damage to persons or property accrues to the University for parked or moving vehicles on campus.

## Guest/Visitor Parking

Guests and visitors may park in any white lined space.

Guest/Visitor parking permits are required at all times including Sunday and holidays.

## NOTICE:

The Department of Public Safety Parking Services Office does NOT adjudicate traffic citations. Payment and appeal information is listed on the reverse side of the traffic citation.

## Regulations

Parking regulations are enforced at ALL times. (24 hours a day, including Saturday, Sunday, and Holiday(s).)

1. Parking is permitted only in SPACES marked for parking.
2. **No Parking is permitted:**
  - ❖ without a properly displayed U.S.D Parking Permit.
  - ❖ by fire hydrants or in fire lanes (ALL aisles and roadways within parking areas are fire lanes)
  - ❖ in handicapped, reserved, official vendor, guest/visitor or other special areas without the appropriate permit, or authorization for that parking area.
  - ❖ in loading zones for more than 10 minutes. Please have your flashers on for the 10 minutes or less that you're there.
  - ❖ in any area marked or painted red, or posted "No Parking."
  - ❖ in pedestrian crosswalks, driveways, landscaped or dirt areas, on sidewalks or in any manner that impedes pedestrian or vehicle traffic flow.
  - ❖ on St Francis Seminary property. This area is restricted parking at ALL times.
  - ❖ within 3 ft of a sidewalk curb cut (handicapped access ramp.)
3. Motorcycles, motor scooters and mopeds **MUST** park in the motorcycle spaces and are **NOT** allowed in bicycle racks or automobile parking spaces.
4. Bicycles **MUST** park in the racks or facilities provided for that purpose.
5. Vehicles (including motor homes or campers) *cannot be used as living units while parked on University of San Diego property.*
6. Campus parking spaces are not to be used as private storage areas for vehicles, boats, trailers, etc.
7. Any gas driven vehicle parked or driven inside any building **WILL** be cited and impounded at owner's expense.
8. **FACULTY/STAFF PARKING SPACES** are painted yellow. Visitor vehicles parked in these areas Saturday **WILL** be cited and/or impounded at owner's expense.
